## IMPROVEMENTS

In the 1990's it was seen that buildings in the department were badly deteriorating and a definate change would soon have to be made, and so many of the buildings in following pictures were abandoned by use of the Fire Department, and new buildings erected under the WPA, Work Project Authority which was organized to keep idle hands working during the depression years.

ENG 20 - who's house is photographed in the picture at the right was a perfect example of the great need for rehabilitation at that time; ENG 20's former house at the right of photo was not only changed, but so was the name of the street from Rawson Street to Concord Place of what we now know it as in the big street name change of 1936. ENG 20 moved from the old quarters on December 5, 1936.

in the early years this house was
headquarters of ENG 3 from Feb 3,
1891 until disbandment May 16,1956

ENG 4 1244 N. Halsted St Original house of Truck 10 until 1884 when ENG 4 occupied same unti Feb 2, 1960.



326 S. Jefferson St

Occupied by company on Jan 26, 1860, and used as temporary quarters by Truck 2 because of Great Fire in 1871 which destroyed their own headquarters on Washington Blvd. Was also quarters for reserve ENG 2, which later was known as ENG 94 in the 1920's. An office building now stands on this site and company has been in newer quarters at 324 S. Desplaines St since 1928.

bn 1936 when company moved to
TRK 4 in Chinatown, 214 W. 22 ND.



ENT 2 2527 Cottage Or Building razed after unit moved to 2341 S. Wabash on Nov 27,1926.



ENF 14 509 W. Chicago Avenue
In 1870 this unit was organized here and
leter was quarters of Truck 3 until new
building was constructed for them at their
present location at 153 W. Erie St. Tower 2
was organized at ENF 14 on Sept 16, 1925.
In 1961, new quarters were built for TRK 19
on the former location at 1129 W. Chicago
Avenue in West Towne, and completed in the
following year, and because of the need of
the property ENF 14 occupied by a commercial
firm, it was deemed necessary and proper to
move ENF 14, and they went in service in
new house of Truck 19 on July 2, 1962,

Organized here in this building
ENG 15 remained until disbandament
