



To help dress up single house of Engine 7 new addition for Truck 58 was added on May 16, 1956 at 4913 W. Belmont Avenue in BELPARK.



On April 4, 1957, these companies ENG 15 and TRUCK 59, were organized in this new building in the growing Scotsdale area at 8026 S. Kedzie.



ENGINES 32 and LADDER 60 later on December 21, 1959 were added to this growing neighborhood of Garfield Ridge at 5559 S. Narragansett Ave.



A temporary move was made on Apr 18, 1960, when ENG 60 and TRUCK 37 moved here in new annex next to TRUCK 16 at 1409 E. 62 Place.



After FIRE PATROL 3 was disbanded in 1959, the city bought this building at 5004 Union Avenue for ENGINE 50 and TRUCK 18. (JULY 26, 1960)



When the Northwest Expressway condemned their quarters on Fairfield Ave this was built for ENG 106 and TRK 13 at 3401 Elston Avenue in '60.



An improvement to the Calumet Harbor area was the addition of ENG 80 and LADDER 61 to ENG 81 in new addition to house at 10458 Hoxie Ave, on June 27, 1961, which made alarms fewer for neighboring TRUCK 17.
